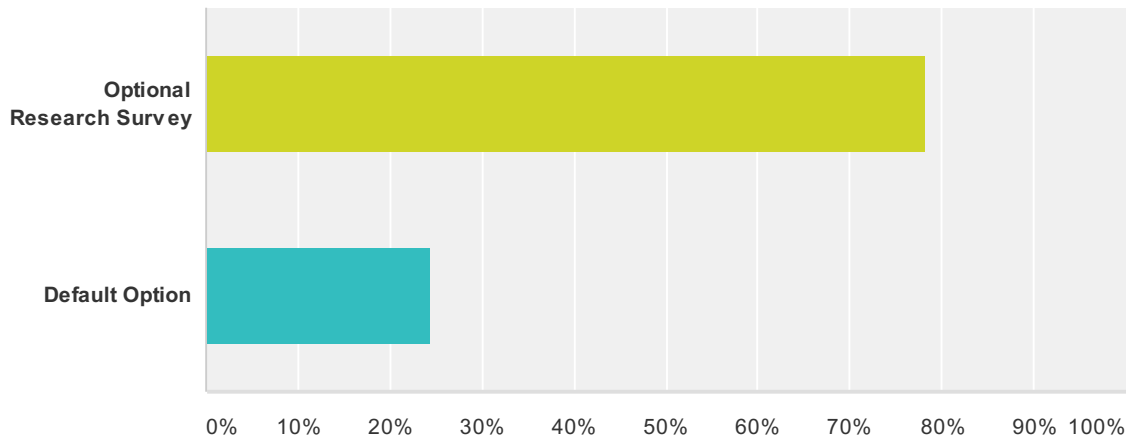

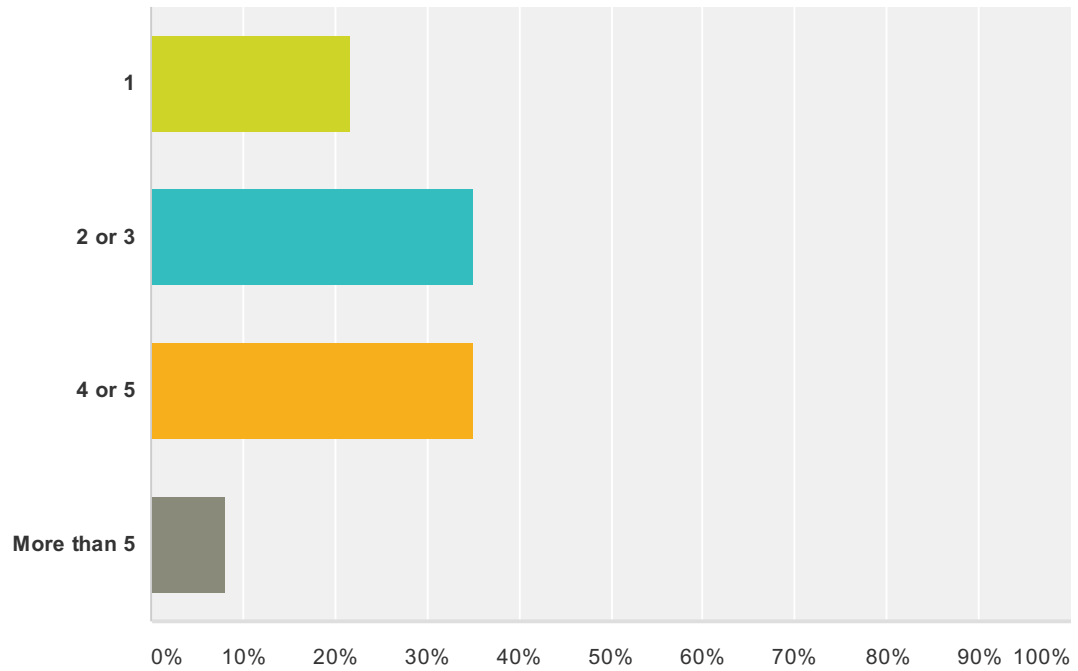

Q2 To how many residency programs did you apply?

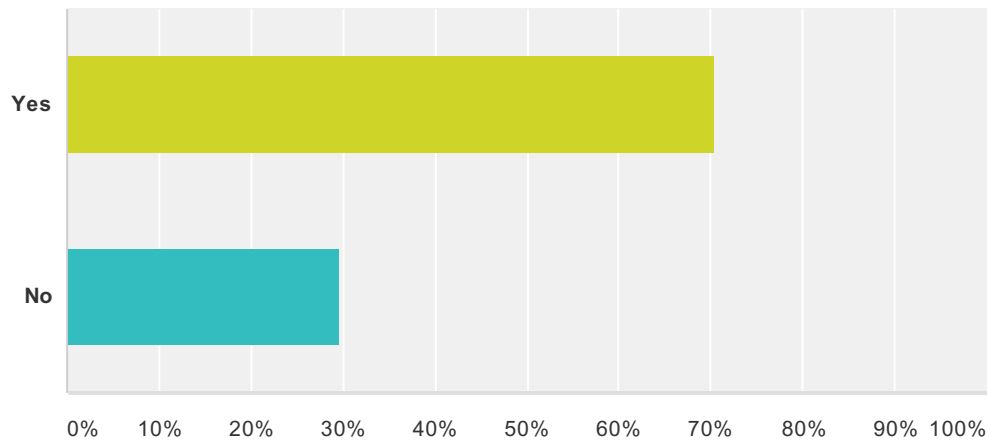

Q3 Is this residency program your first choice?

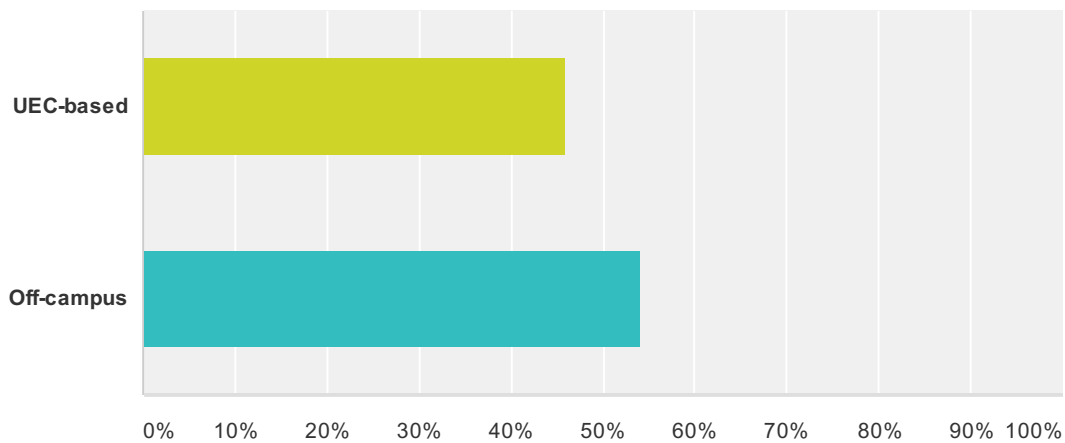

Q4 Are you in a UEC-based residency or one that is primarily off campus?

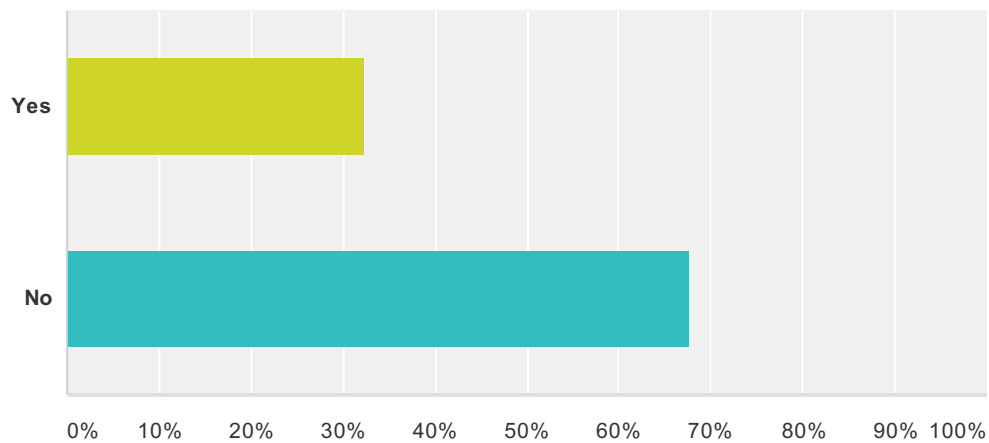

Q5 Did you graduate from SUNY College of Optometry?

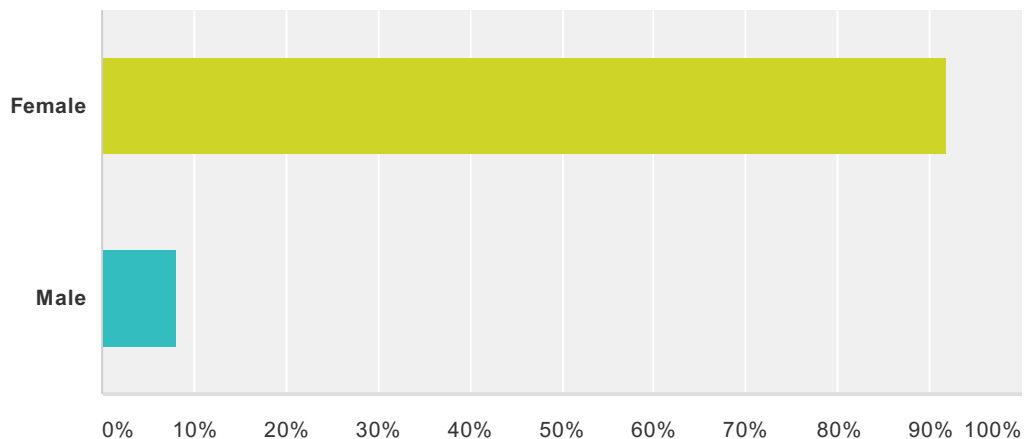

Q6 What is your gender?

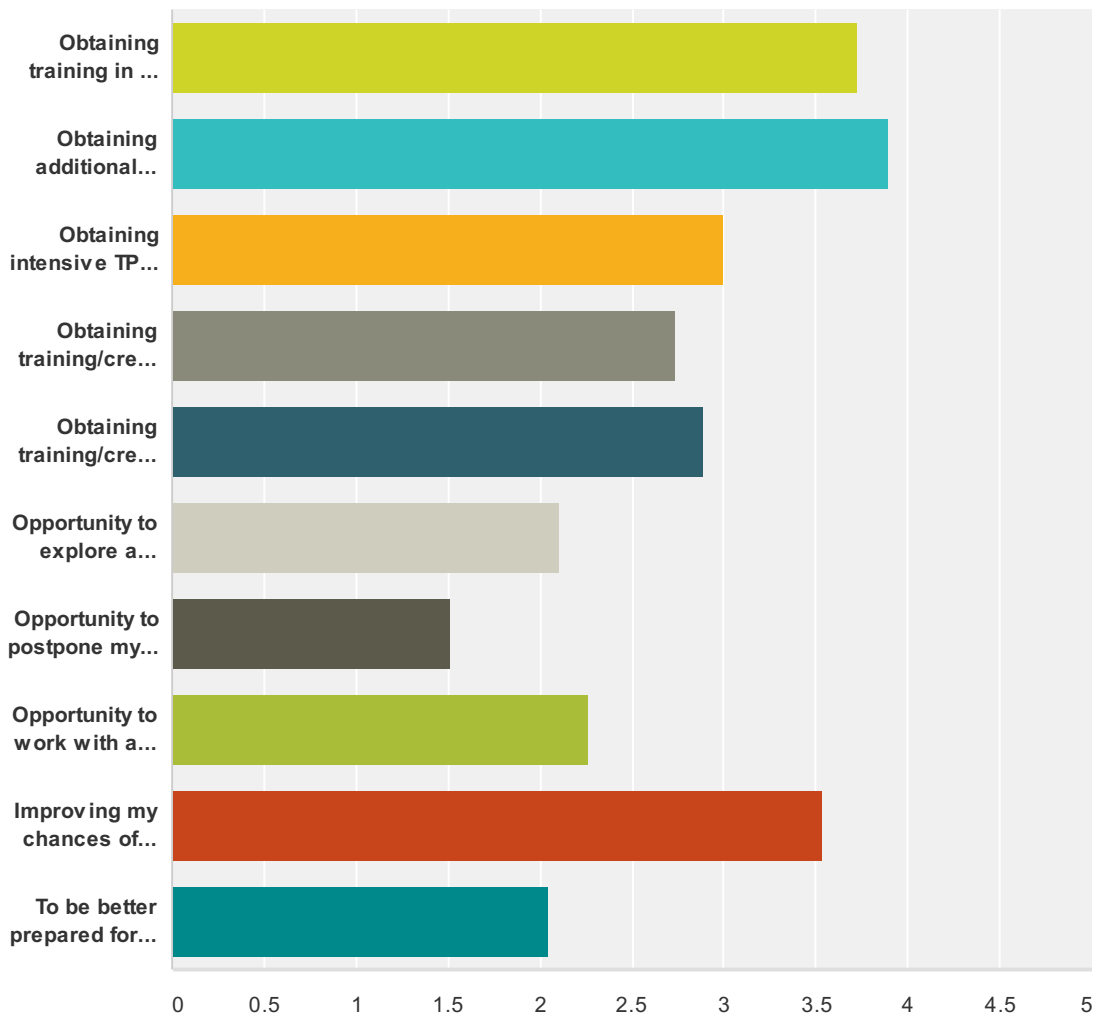

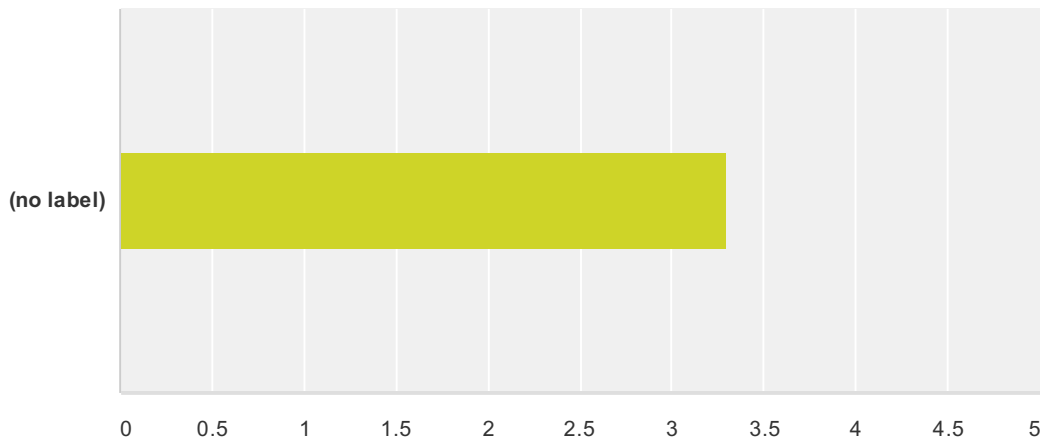

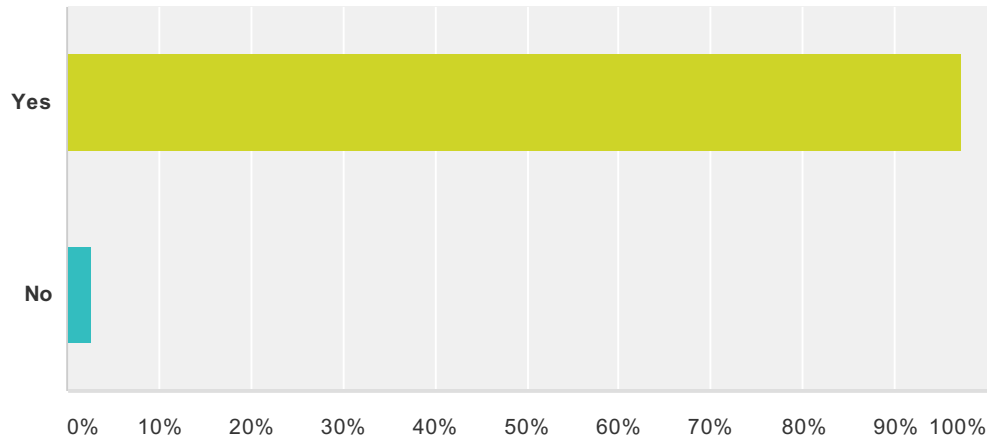

Q9 If you had it to do over again, would you do a residency?

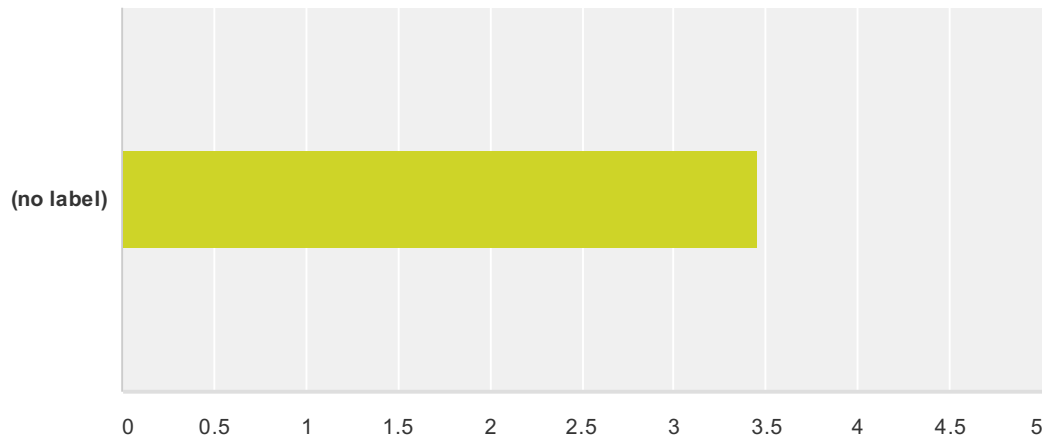

Q10 By doing my residency I have increased my chances to obtain the type of optometric position that I want.

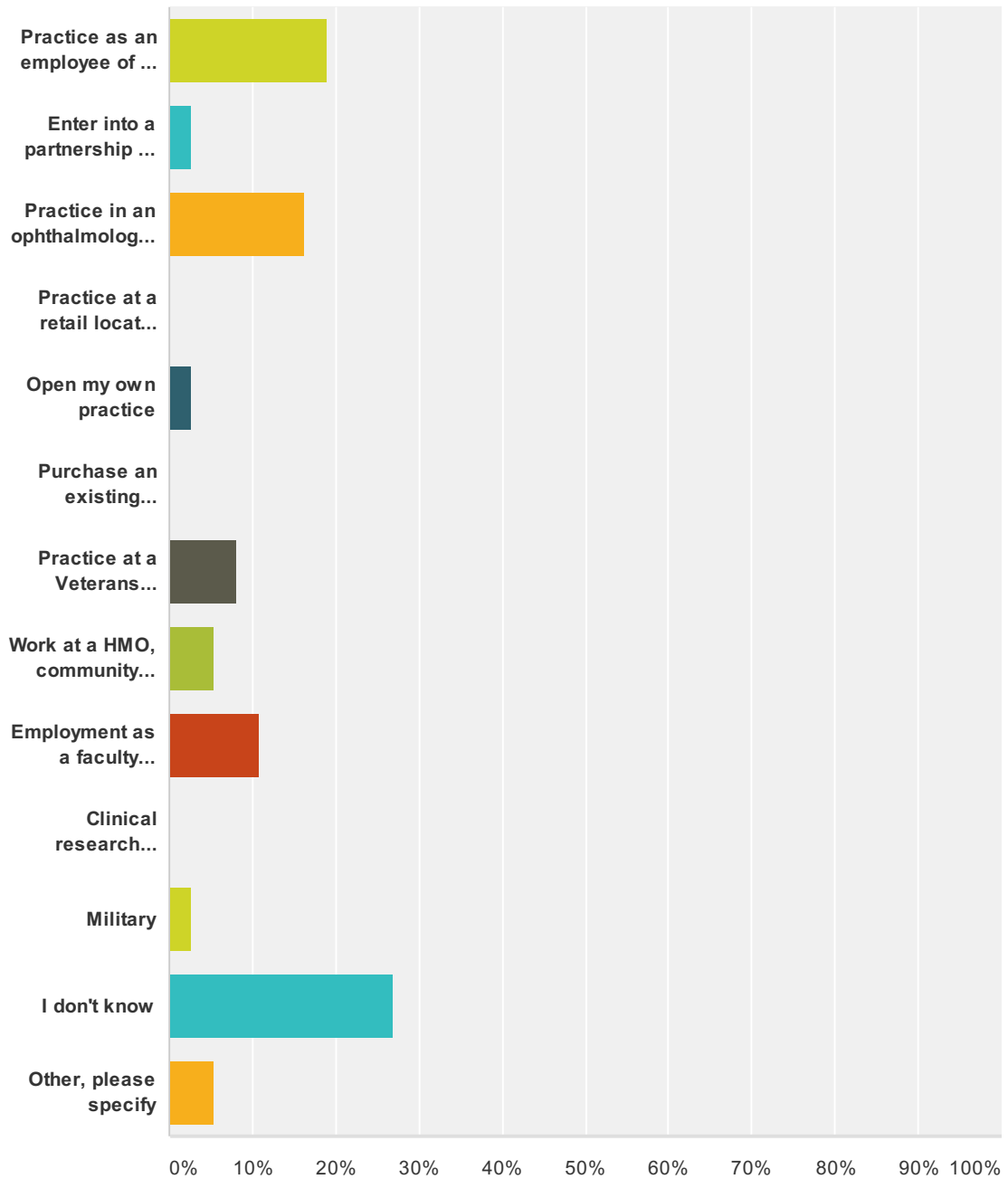

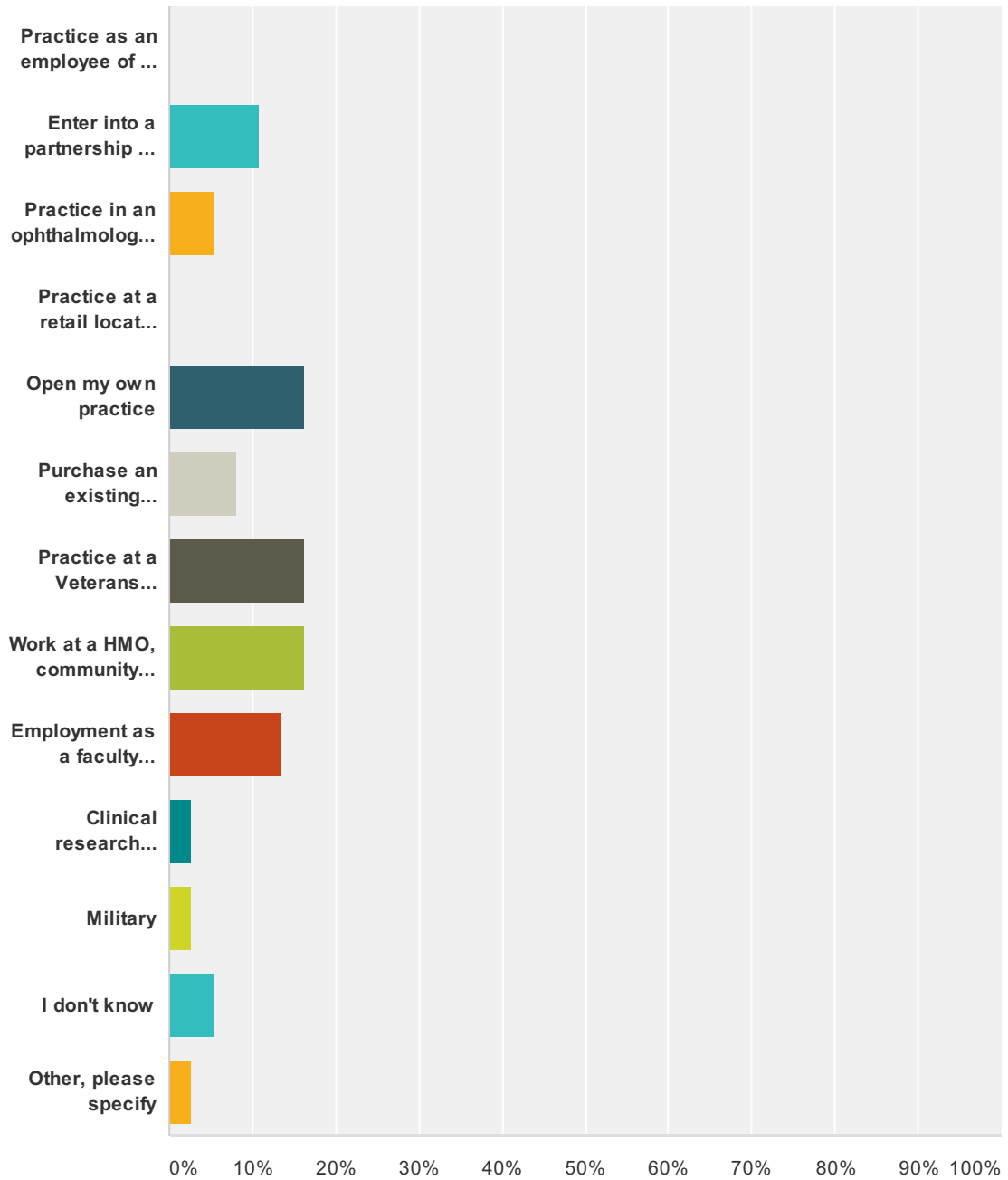

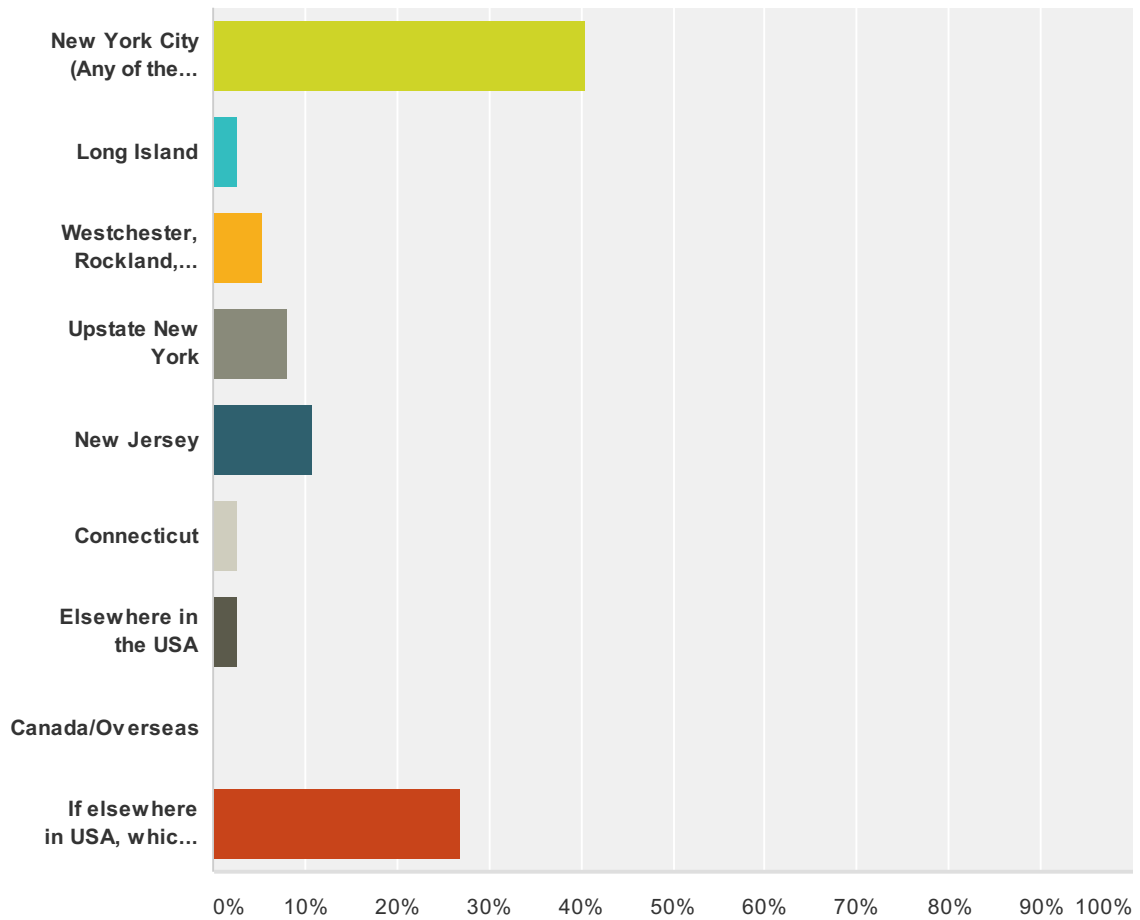

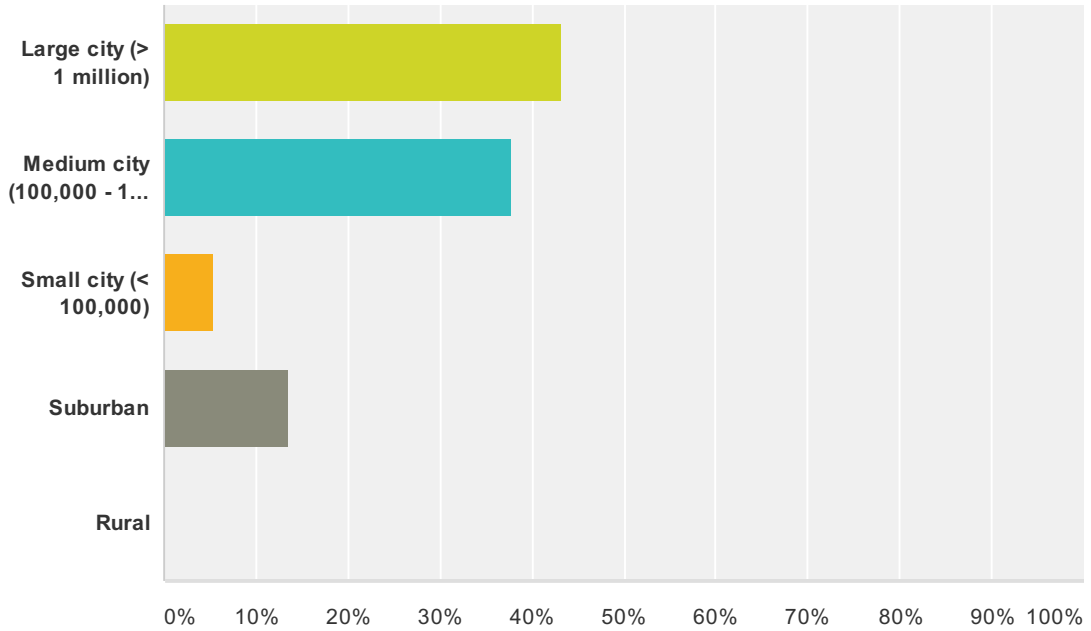

Q14 Which best describes the community where you intend to practice.

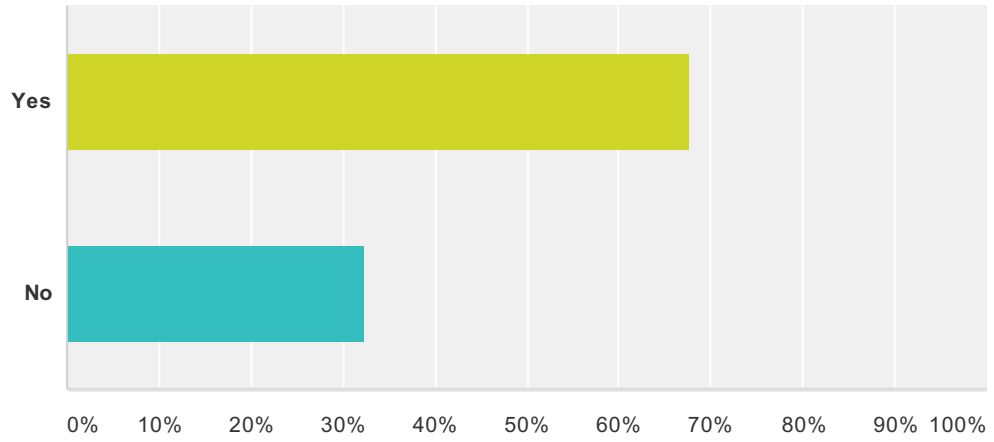

Q15 Do you believe that completion of your residency program will result in a higher initial income than if you had not completed the program?

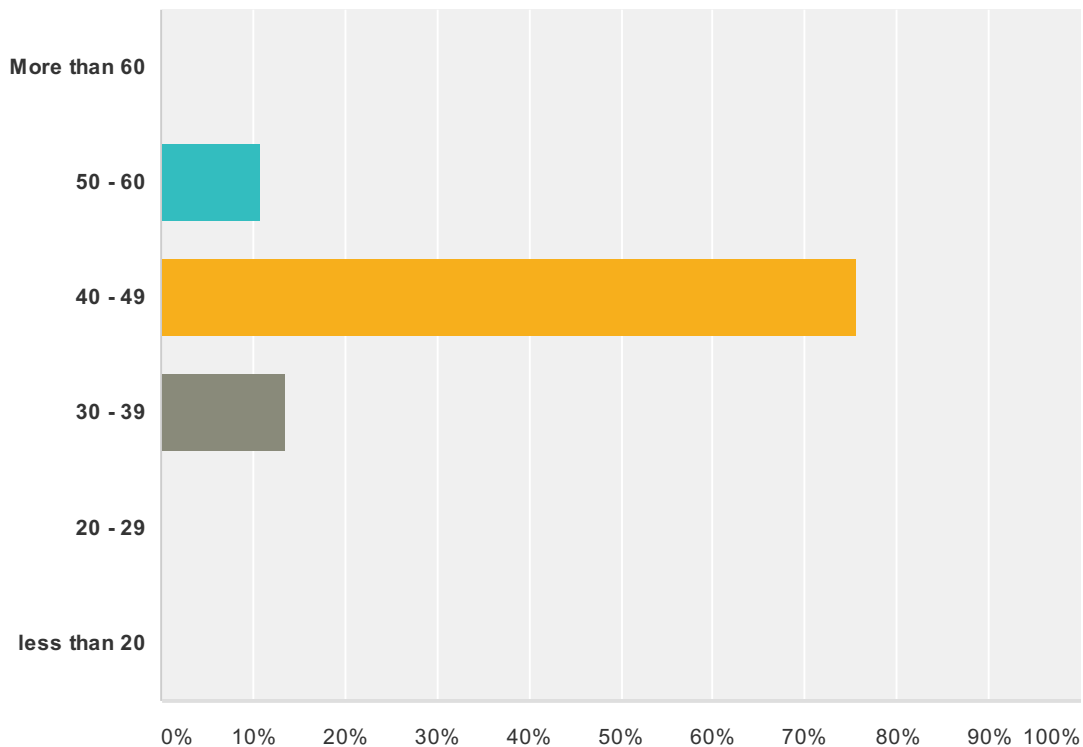

Q16 Upon completion of your residency program, how many hours per week do you expect to work/practice?

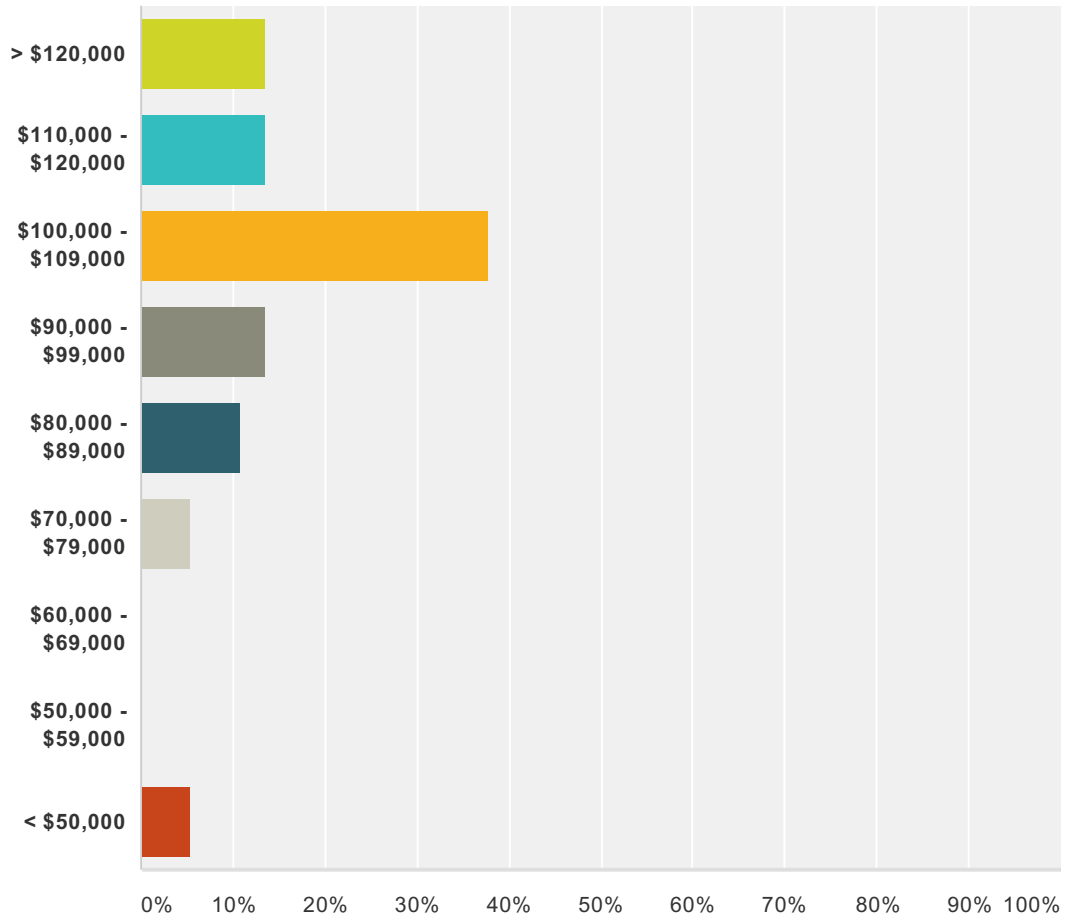

Q17 What optometric income do you expect for your first full year following completion of your residency?

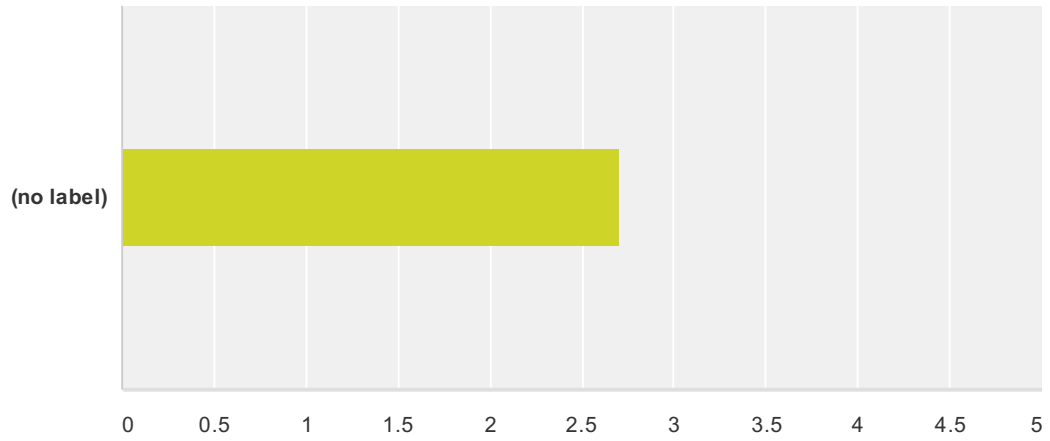

Q18 What are your perceptions of the job market for optometrists with residency training?

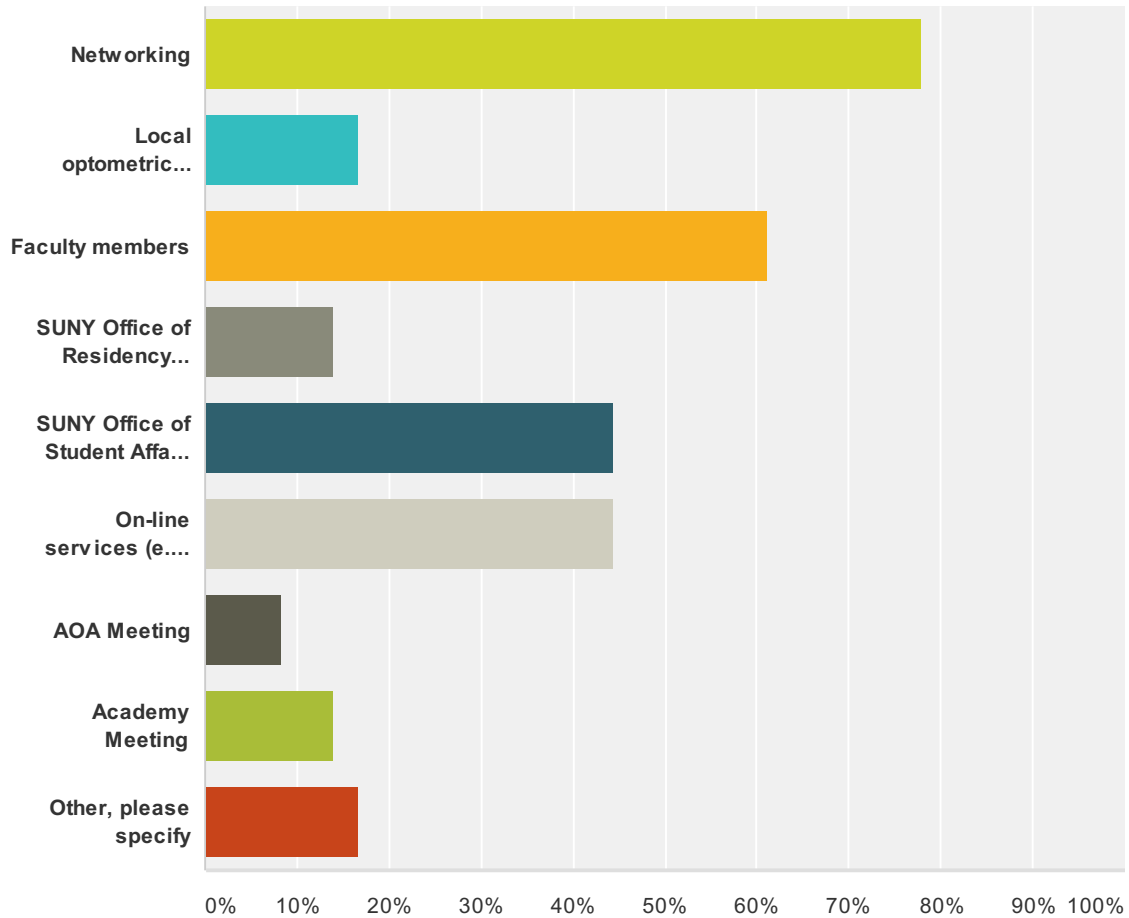

Q19 When looking for your first position following completion of your residency program, which strategies/resources have you utilized? (You may select more than one.)

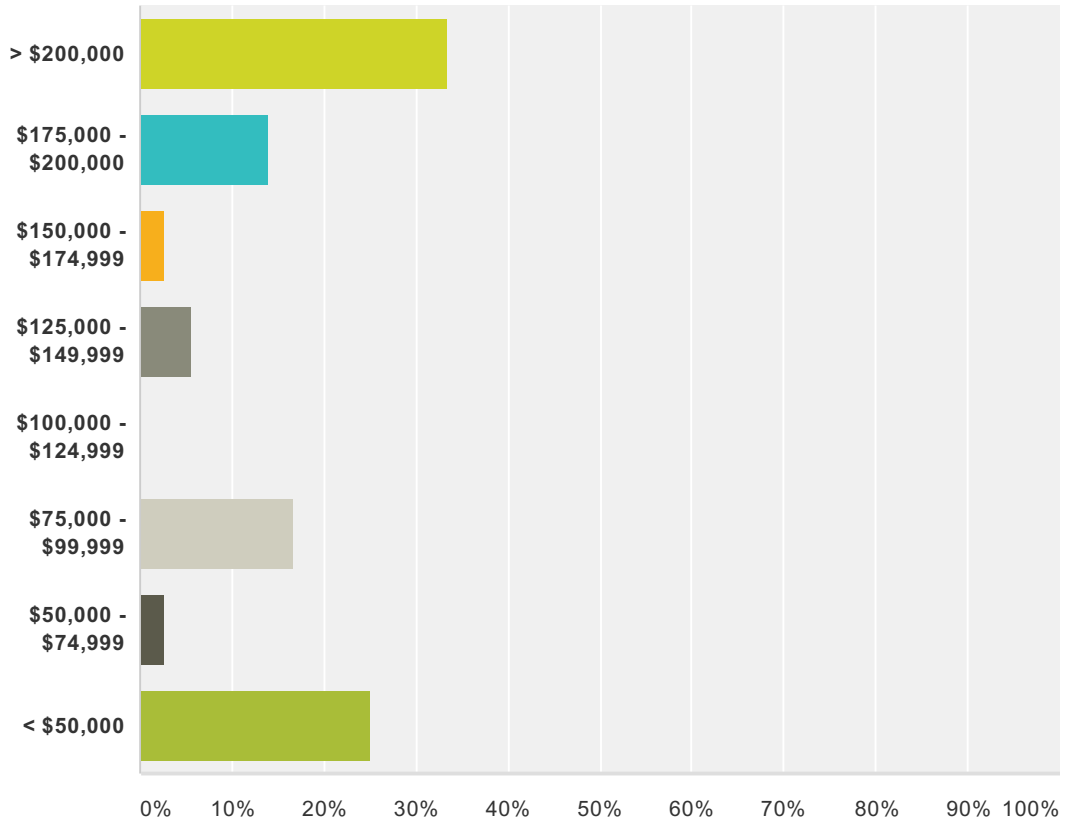

Q20 Upon completion of your residency program, what will be your total (undergraduate and optometry) educational indebtedness?

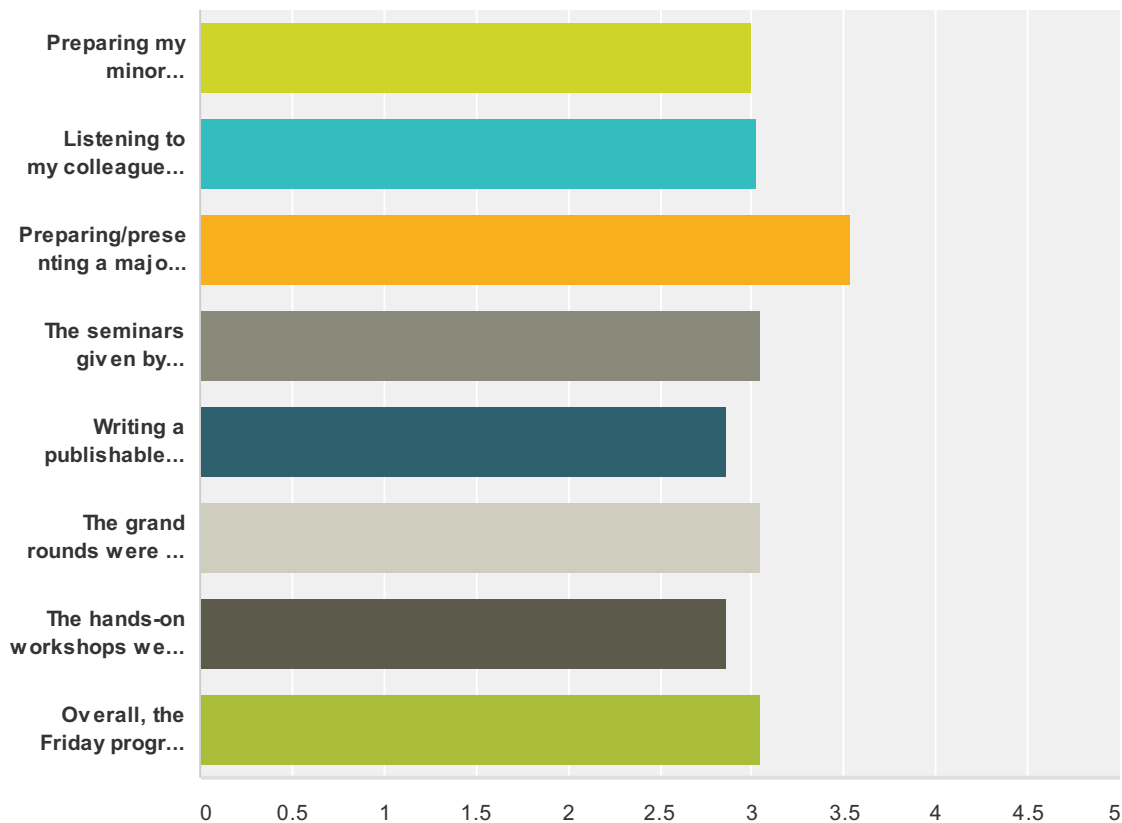

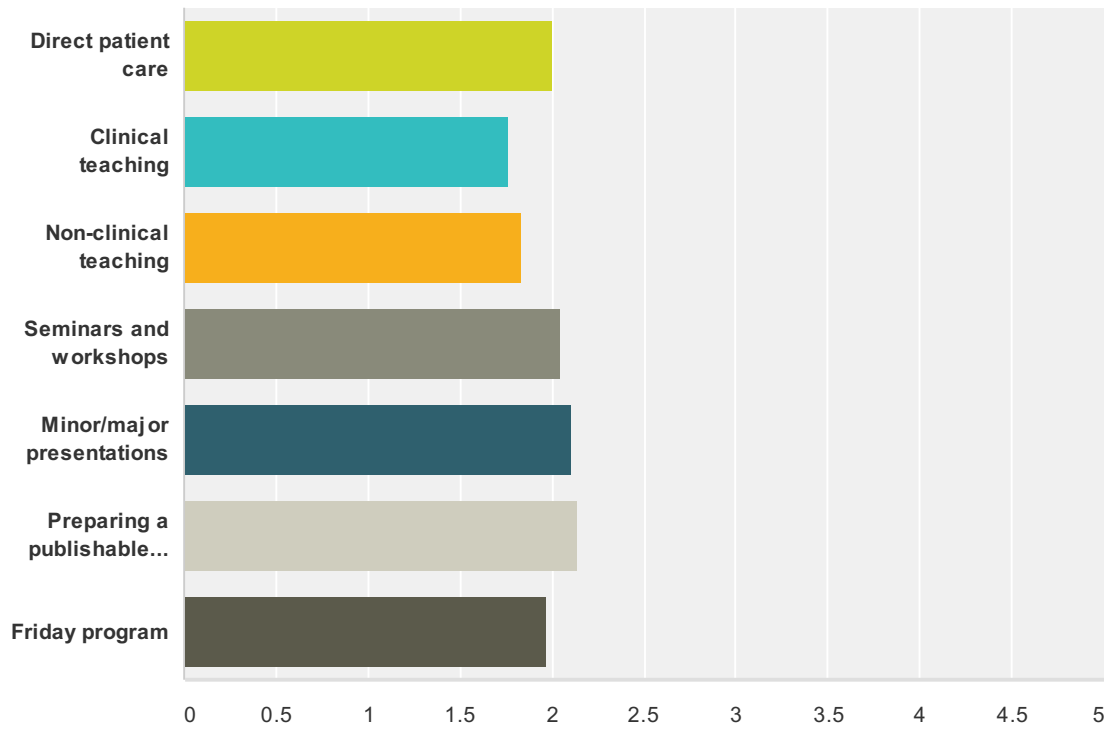

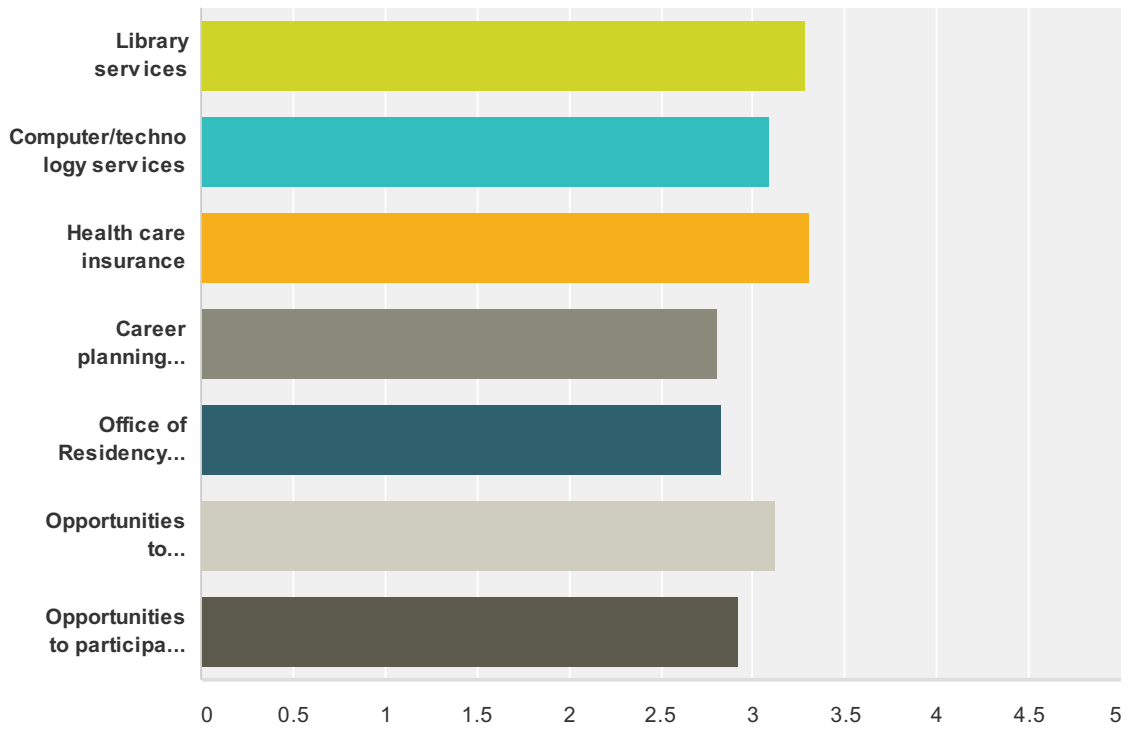
